August solar power generation was 3,310,958kWh, 4% above the forecast.

While panel failures at the Ichigo Nago Futami ECO Power Plant have lowered production, there is no material impact on earnings due to base revenue guarantees from Ichigo Green’s operator.

¹ Forecast Power Generation is calculated by the asset management company based on the average actual power generation of each plant over the last three years.

² CO2 reduction is calculated using the adjusted CO2 emission factor disclosed annually by the Ministry of Environment on March 1, which serves as a fixed constant until the following February. The factor is 0.423kg CO2 per kWh, except for the Ichigo Nago Futami ECO Power Plant, which is 0.707kg CO2 per kWh.
